MAIN ST. BRIDGE IN EULESS TO BE REMOVED THIS WEEKEND

Full highway closures to be implemented this weekend on SH 183 in Euless

EULESS (June 8, 2016) — Pending inclement weather, SouthGate Constructors will remove the Main St. bridge and partially remove the adjacent pedestrian bridge starting at 11 PM on Friday, June 10. In order to remove the bridges, the following phased closures will be in place:

Times: From 11PM on Friday, June 10 to 11PM on Saturday, June 11

- Full highway closure of eastbound SH 183 at Industrial Blvd. [Click here for detour.](#)
- Full highway closure of westbound SH 183 at Main St. [Click here for detour.](#)
- All lanes of north and southbound Industrial Blvd. and Ector Dr. closed under SH 183.
- Eastbound SH 183 toll managed lanes must exit at Industrial Blvd.
- Eastbound SH 183 on-ramp from Murphy Dr. closed.
- Eastbound SH 183 on-ramp from Industrial Blvd. closed.

Times: From 11PM on Saturday, June 11 to 6AM on Monday, June 13

- Full highway closure of eastbound and westbound SH 183 at Main St. only. [Click here for detour.](#)
- Eastbound SH 183 on-ramp from Industrial Blvd. closed.

The Main St. bridge is being closed in order to remove the current structure and build a new, wider bridge. The new bridge will be built and open to traffic within 18 months.

The 28-mile Midtown Express project (SH 183 Managed Lanes Project) is expected to improve mobility by expanding SH 183 from SH 121 in Euless to Interstate (I) 35E in Dallas, as well as SH 114 from SH 183 to SH 121/International Parkway and a portion of Loop 12 from SH 183 to I-35E. The \$847 million project includes design, reconstruction and rehabilitation of deteriorating roadways and the addition of toll managed lanes.
