TWO MAJOR PIECES OF WORK TO TAKE PLACE ON MIDTOWN EXPRESS THIS WEEKEND

Ramp closure on eastbound SH 183 to northbound Spur 482 to complete traffic switch; north and southbound Story Rd. closed.

IRVING (September 26, 2017) — Pending inclement weather or schedule changes, SouthGate Constructors will move the eastbound SH 183 off-ramp to northbound Spur 482 ramp onto a new bridge this weekend. A visual of the new traffic pattern is included with this advisory. In addition, north and southbound Story Rd. under SH 183 will be closed all weekend for drainage work.

From 9PM on Friday, September 29 to 6AM on Monday, October 2

TRAFFIC SWITCH CLOSURES:

- **Frontage Rd.:**
 - Eastbound SH 183 near Maryland Rd. closed. Click for detour.
- **Ramps:**
 - The eastbound SH 183 off-ramp to northbound Spur 482. Click for detour.

CITY STREET CLOSURE (Click links for detours):

- North and southbound Story Rd. under SH 183 will be closed.

Portable changeable message boards have been placed in advance to inform the traveling public of the closures. Drivers should expect delays and plan accordingly.

The 28-mile Midtown Express project (SH 183 Managed Lanes Project) is expected to improve mobility by expanding SH 183 from SH 121 in Euless to Interstate (I) 35E in Dallas, as well as SH 114 from SH 183 to SH 121/International Parkway and a portion of Loop 12 from SH 183 to I-35E. The \$847 million project includes design, reconstruction and rehabilitation of deteriorating roadways and the addition of toll managed lanes.
